

Awards and Medals Committee

The Awards and Medals Committee shall:

1. Review the list of members recommended for awards at the TNSSAR Annual Membership Meeting and determine whether the proposed recipients are qualified for the medals and awards that they might receive.
2. Assure that the qualifications outlined in the Medals and Awards Section of the National Society Handbook are followed. Where discrepancies exist, it shall inform the President or other awarding authority that there is a conflict. It will, if necessary, contact the National Awards and Medals Committee Chairman for resolution of conflicts that cannot be resolved at the State or Chapter level.
3. Be responsible for seeing that the awards are made and/or presented in a manner befitting this Society.
4. See that medals at the State level are properly engraved and certificates are properly engrossed. It will ensure that they are physically transported to the scene of the Annual Membership meeting.
5. Assign the responsibility of procuring, engraving, engrossing, and delivery any awards which may be recommended for presentation by another committee to the Chairman of the requesting committee.
6. Collect from each chapter a list of all awards presented by that chapter. Annually or before July 1 of each year, it shall furnish to the State Secretary (with a copy to the State Historian) a list of all awards presented by the TNSSAR and by each of its chapters during the preceding twelve months. This report is to become a part of the permanent State Record.
