

### **Section 3 - Application for Reinstatement of Membership**

#### A. National Society of the Sons of the American Revolution

##### 1. NSSAR Handbook, By-law 19, Section 9

“Any member, whose membership has been terminated for any cause, except terminations under the provision of Bylaw 17, Section 3, may be reinstated by any State Society, in which event such State Society shall immediately report such reinstatement to the National Society, and shall at the same time pay to the National Society the annual dues for such member for the then current year, and he shall thereupon be entered on the records of the Registrar General. Reinstatements received in accordance with the provisions hereof after October 31 shall be credited to the following year.”

The fees paid to the National Society by the State Society shall be equal to the current annual membership dues plus any record copy fee."

*It is the intent of this section to define the reinstatement of a member into a Society other than the one from which he dropped for non-payment of dues (NPD.) This type of reinstatement will require the proper completion of the REINSTATEMENT FORM (Exhibit XIII, By-law 19). To reinstate into the State Society from which he was dropped the member need only pay his State and National dues - no additional forms need be completed.*

#### B. Process

1. To receive a Reinstated Member, The TNSSAR Secretary should receive the By-law 19 Form 0918, rev. 9/1999, or later, completed at the top by the member requesting reinstatement. The Secretary will then forward a copy of the Reinstatement Form to the Registrar General, NSSAR, along with the appropriate fees and a transmittal form. The request of the National Office will include a request for a copy of the member's original application for his files. The fee will therefore include the National dues and the cost of a record copy of the members application. The Registrar General will assign the Compatriot a new Tennessee State Number and will forward the TNSSAR Secretary a Transmittal with this information. The Secretary will then forward a copy of the Transmittal to the Registrar along with the record copy of the members original application.
2. The TNSSAR Secretary will not process any reinstatement without the proper fees of National dues, State dues, Chapter dues and the record copy fee having been paid.
