

Section 5 - Application for Transfer of Membership between State Societies

A. National Society of the Sons of the American Revolution

1. NSSAR Handbook

"A member in good standing may transfer to any other State Society, subject to the acceptance of that body. Transfer forms are available from State Societies or National Headquarters. After being signed by the Secretary of the State Society of current affiliation and the Secretary of the State Society to which transfer is desired, the form is to be sent to National Headquarters for registration. Assignment of new state society number will be made by the receiving state."

B. Tennessee Society of the Sons of the American Revolution

1. "Compatriots applying to the Tennessee Society for transfer from another state shall not pay an initiation fee but must pay any applicable dues in advance with their application and any fee required by the National Society."

Transfer of State Membership applications must be accompanied by a Record Copy of their original application or a fee will be assessed. The fee will be the Record Copy fee required by the National Society if the member is currently a member in good standing with the State of current membership. The member's National, State and Chapter dues must also accompany his application if the Transfer is a Transfer-Reinstatement for a currently inactive member.

C. Process

1. To receive a Transferred Member, the TNSSAR Secretary should receive the Application for Transfer or Application for Reinstatement Form completed at the top by the member requesting transfer. This form does require the member's signature. The Secretary will then forward a copy of the Application Form to the following: One copy to Registrar, one copy to the Treasurer accompanied by the applicant's check for applicable fees and one copy to the Registrar General, NSSAR, along with a TNSSAR check for the appropriate fees under cover of a Transmittal. The Registrar General will assign the Compatriot a Tennessee State Number and will forward to the TNSSAR Secretary a Transmittal with this information. The Secretary will then forward a copy of the Transmittal to the above officers and the NSSAR supplied Record Copy of the member's application to the State Registrar. The Registrar will then file the Application for Transfer of Membership and the Record Copy of the member's original application in his files. The cost of the original application Record Copy will be borne by the member wishing transfer of membership.
2. The TNSSAR Secretary will not process any transfer or transfer- reinstatement without the proper fees having been paid.
