

**Section 7 -REQUEST FOR COPIES OF SAR OR DAR
ANCESTOR OR MEMBER APPLICATIONS**

A. National Society Daughters of the American Revolution Handbook

1. Registrar General - Record Copy

Requests for DAR Record Copy should be forwarded on the "Request For Record Copy" form available from the DAR web site at www.dar.org or the TNSSAR Secretary.

B. National Society of the Sons of the American Revolution

1. Registrar General - Record Copy

The NSSAR Office of Registrar General will send a record copy of the application of a member to authorized persons upon request and payment of the fee for making the copy. Requests for Application Copies should include (as a minimum): Applicant's Name, Ancestor's Name (if known) and National Number. Many reference books and the SAR Patriots CD have been developed that give NSSAR ancestors' names by surname and have these cross referenced to current Compatriots.

Please Note: Many applications use an already proven line and reference an established NSSAR or NSDAR application. If these lines are used, the application must be a record copy from the Registrar General of either organization. In addition, if the record copy is missing data from the application, the new applicant must make a concerted effort to "fill in the blanks" where he can. Since these applications will be used in the future to prove membership in this organization, every effort must be made to improve the documentation filed at the appropriate headquarters.
