## Patriot Biography

John Johnston was born in Tyrone Co, Ireland on 17 Mar 1734 and died in Nashville/Davidson Co, TN on 01 Mar 1816. He is buried in Williamson Co, TN. His wife, Elizabeth Locke was born in 1742 in Doylestown/Bucks Co, PA and died 15 Jun 1815 in Nashville, TN. She is buried beside John in Johnson Chapel Cemetery. They married 17 May 1762 in Rowan Co, NC.

John was a Capt and later a Maj in the Rowan Co militia and served under Col Francis Locke for a period of time. He later served under Col Matthew Locke and in 1780 at the battle of Colson's Mill under Col William Lee Davidson. This was in a Mecklenburg Co regiment. He was Capt of the "Fork Rangers" for four years.

John and his family were apparently in Williamson Co, TN by 1801. He was paying tax on 150 acres of land and one white pole. He supposedly donated the land for Johnson Chapel Methodist Church and the cemetery.

The children of John and Elizabeth were sons John, Robert and Matthew Locke and daughters Margaret, Mary, Sarah, Agnes, Elizabeth, Anne and Eleanor. The youngest son and daughter were twins.
