<p>Submit a Biography of 200 – 500 words:</p> <p>Thomas Cox was born in Baltimore, MD on 03 Jun 1761 and died in Davidson Co, TN on 13 Dec 1830. Names of his parents are unknown at this time. He married Rebecca Webb about 1790. No marriage record has been found at this time.</p> <p>Rebecca was born 24 Aug 1770 and died 08 Sep 1827. According to survey records of 1933 she is also buried at Johnson Chapel beside Thomas. The stone for Rebecca is completely gone.</p> <p>Thomas came to middle Tennessee with those that founded Nashville with the settlement of Fort Nashborough on the Cumberland River.
